**Welcome to Seattle, Washington (USA)**

Please keep Deck 5, Atrium clear. We invite you to relax in your Stateroom or any one of the public lounges until you hear your luggage tag color called. Please have your proof of citizenship in hand as well as your Sun Guest Keycard as you disembark the vessel. U.S. Customs & Border Protection inspection will take place inside the terminal. We anticipate starting debarkation at approximately 7:30am & anticipate all guests to be ashore by approximately 10:00am.

## **5:30am-10:00am    SETTling YOUR ACCOUNT    Atrium, Deck 5, Mid**

An itemized statement of your On Board Credit Account will be delivered to your stateroom after 2:00am on Saturday morning. If you are settling your account with cash or travelers checks, or if you have any discrepancies with your billing please take care of them at the Onboard Credit Desk in the Atrium, Deck 5. If you have made arrangements to settle your account with a credit card, your charges will automatically be billed to your credit card and it will not be necessary to go to the Desk. All accounts must be settled onboard before disembarking.

## **US CUSTOMS & BORDER PROTECTION INSPECTIONS**

U.S. Customs and Border Protection officials will give the debarkation clearance and all guests will be inspected in the terminal. We ask you to wait comfortably in the public lounges or your stateroom to avoid congestion at the Gangway. For security reasons, we request that you keep all your hand luggage with you at all times. Once the ship has been cleared by U.S. Customs, we will start our debarkation process, estimated to start at **approximately 7:30AM. Please do not proceed to the gangway until your color has been called, as your luggage won't be available until that time.** As you leave, you will be asked to swipe your Key Card (stateroom key) one last time at the gangway. You may keep your Key Card as a souvenir from this voyage.

Once you have been cleared by U.S. Customs and Border Protection you will then proceed to the baggage claim area to collect your luggage on the pier. As needed, luggage porters will be on hand to assist you. U.S. Customs will be in the luggage area for random inspections.

Finally, ground transportation & NCL ground staff to assist will be waiting for you just outside the baggage claim area. As you exit the Seattle Terminal, U.S. Customs Officials will collect your completed Customs Declaration form (filled, signed and dated). To expedite this process, please have this document available in hand.



## FILLING OUT YOUR U.S. CUSTOMS FORM

All Heads of Households, regardless of nationality, must complete one **U.S. Customs Declaration Form** to include those family members traveling with you and residing at the same address.

**YOU MUST DECLARE THE TOTAL VALUE OF ALL ARTICLES ACQUIRED ABROAD** that you are bringing into the United States, including those items purchased on the ship. All tax-free items (i.e. artwork, unset precious gemstones, perfume, cosmetics, antiques and U.S. made products), must be listed on the back of the Customs declaration form. **Undeclared merchandise is subject to seizure and/or penalty.** If you have exceeded your Customs exemption, you must list **all** purchases on the back of the Customs form and the head of the household must present themselves with receipts to U.S. Customs in the terminal in Seattle.

### Your Customs exemption includes:

- Purchases up to \$800 per person
- 1 carton of 200 cigarettes – must be 21 years or older. Excess U.S. Cigarettes marked with "U.S. tax-exempt for use outside U.S." or "made for export only" will be seized. Foreign manufactured tobacco products will be subject to duty and internal revenue taxes.
- 100 Cigars (No Cuban cigars allowed) – must be 21 years or older
- 1 liter of alcohol – must be 21 years or older. Applicable internal revenue taxes and duties will be assessed on alcohol overages.

**Prohibited Items:** Fruits, nuts, plants, soil, flowers, drugs, narcotics, indecent materials, Cuban cigars, African ivory, Snake skin, Turtle shell products, guns or weapons

**Special Note:** As per US Customs and Border Protection Officials, strictly NO photography or videotaping is allowed in the terminal. The use of cellular phones is also prohibited.

## LUGGAGE INFORMATION

Place your luggage outside your stateroom no later than 3:00am Saturday morning. Please remember to keep an overnight bag for the following day. Do not pack any medication, valuables, breakables or documents (passports, stateroom keys, etc.)

Any alcohol that was collected or purchased and held throughout the cruise may be retrieved. All items that were confiscated and held throughout the cruise will also be available.


